

Inventory and Production Management in Supply Chains

by Edward A. Silver, David F. Pyke and Douglas J. Thomas



Key points regarding the 4th edition:

- 1) There is a continued emphasis on bridging the gap between theory and practice.
- 2) New material has been added to address several key supply chain management concepts. This includes a new chapter addressing coordination of inventory and planning decisions within and across firms. For example, treatment of collaborative forecasting, vendor managed inventory, sales and operations planning, and postponement has been added or expanded.
- 3) This edition includes expanded discussion of modern information systems to support inventory and production decision making.
- 4) As with the earlier editions, references throughout have been updated to provide the reader with an up-to-date, extensive bibliography.
